Job requires above average physical stamina, willingness to learn and ability to follow instructions . Candidates must be able to pass both a <u>pre-employment drug screen and a comprehensive</u> **background check.**

Physical Demands

The employee must frequently lift and/or move more than 75 pounds and occasionally move weights in the excess of 100lbs.
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus. Corrective lens if needed must be worn at all times of vehicle operation and paperwork preparation.
